Report on Activities in 2001

t the general body meeting held on Dec 9, 2001, A Niru Shah presented the following list of various activities held in 2001: Regular Sunday classes for children and adults; Membership Drive and Publication of Members' Directory: Celebration of Mahavir Jayanti with children's stage programs; Celebration of 2600th Mahavir Janma Kalyanak Day; Paryushan Parva celebration with Diptiben Shah, including Swapna ceremony and Samvatsari Pratikraman for adults and children in parallel; Nationwide broadcasting of our Swapna Ceremony program by PBS; Celebration of Das Lakshan Parva with Ramnikbhai Savla; Panch Teerth Yatra bus trip to temples in Cherryhill, Caldwell, Siddhachalam, Allentown, Harrisburg and Vraj; Nav Smaran program on the new year's day; Numerous activities by Youths including bowling and Regional Youth Conference; Recital of Jain prayer in US congress and reception of all delegates at our Jain Center; Pravachan by Jain Scholars; Pooja and Bhavana programs; Ayambil programs; Prayer program for the victims of September 11th attack; Fund-raising for earthquake victims in Gujarat as well as for the victims of the September 11th attack; Establishing a home page on the internet for our Jain Society; Setting up e-mail list for notifications of events; Temple being open on Sundays from 11.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m.; Participation in the Diwali Mela program by Association of Hindu & Jain Temples of Washington; Participation in Interfaith activities; and Capital Improvements including two bathrooms, water fountain and outside concrete.

Treasurer's Report

At the general body meeting, Treasurer, Manu J. Shah, presented the following financial report: The total revenue received from January 1 to December 8, 2001 was \$103,120. The revenue included \$18,298 for Earthquake Relief Fund and \$1000 for Sept 11 Victims Relief Fund. The total expenses during that period were \$63,155. These expenses included \$18,418 sent to JAINA for Earthquake Relief Fund, and \$1000 sent for Sept 11 Victims Relief Fund. Current assets included cash deposits of \$397,643.

President's Report on Accomplishments in 2001

At the general body meeting, Vice President Dhiraj Shah read the following Report prepared by our president Kanta Dharamsi:

You heard details of various activities held this year from our secretary Niru Shah. I would like to summarize our various major accomplishments this year, the 2600th Janma Kalyanak year of Lord Mahavir.

One of the biggest accomplishments was the Jain prayer held in the US Congress on May 22 wherein we made a history. It was also unique in that all JAINA presidents came at our request and attended the prayer and the reception held the day before. Special thanks to Sushil Jain and Manoj Dharamsi for arranging this history-making program.

Another big accomplishment was the broadcast of a short edited version our Swapna Ceremony throughout the nation by Public Broadcasting Service (PBS) on 26 August. PBS came to our program and shot the whole program as well as took some interviews at our temple. I understand that they will use the video to show it at other times. Again thanks to Sushil Jain for arranging it.

Our new Members' Directory has been published and been mailed out to all members, all Jain organizations in North America, and to local organizations. This project will bring net revenue of over \$6000 to our Society. Thanks to Manoj Dharamsi for leading the project, and Hemal Jhaveri, Nisha Jain, Jignesh Dalal, Ina Shah, Niru Shah, Ashok P. Shah, Kanu Doshi, and Rajiv Shah for working on it.

Another accomplishment is the setting up of our website jsmw.org. Thanks to Kala Jain for setting it up and keeping it updated. Also, thanks to Nisha Jain for setting up our e-mail address jsmw@mail.com, responding to mails, and sending quick response messages by e-mail to all members who have provided their e-mail address to us.

We took active part in raising funds for the earthquake relief fund for India, and for the relief fund to support victims of the terrorist attack in New York and Washington.

Our members are taking active part in various JAINA committees viz. Mahavir Memorial Committee, Public Relations Committee, World Community Service Committee, Membership Committee, and I would like to thank Interfaith Committee. following persons for chairing these committees, and doing an excellent job: Bachubhai Ajmera, Manoj Dharamsi, Bhadresh Dhila, Sushil Jain, Prakash Mehta., and Kamlesh Shah. Mahavir Memorial Committee and Public Relations Committee arranged Jain prayers, published a leaflet and arranged programs throughout this year to celebrate 2600th birth year of lord Mahavir. World Community Service Committee raised large funds for the earthquake relief fund and opened a JAINA village Mahavir Nagar near Bhuj in Kutch.

We took active part in YJA regional conventions. Thanks to Nisha Jain and Sushil Jain and Youth Committee for it.

Our members (Sushil Jain & Manoj Dharamsi) took active part in the interfaith activities. In fact, lectures on Jainism were arranged at 3 places, and thanks to Kanubhai Doshi for that. Also thanks to Manu G. Shah and Sushil Jain for taking active part in the Diwali Mela celebration this year.

We have done a number of improvements done at our Jain Center. These include: converting the utility room to a room with two bathrooms, and a water fountain; expanding the outdoor concreted area; putting motion detector lights around the building; setting up speakers in this hall; rearranging the parking lot, and a number of other small repairs required.

In closing, I would like to thank all members of executive committee for their excellent work. I would also like to thank trustees, youth committee, and all those who provided their support in carrying out various activities this year. Also, thanks to all members for their participation and generous donations.
