Paryushan Parva will be celebrated from Wednesday August 15 to Wednesday August 22. We are pleased to announce that **Diptiben Shah** has kindly agreed to grace the celebration. She is a Jain Scholar from Mumbai, India. Last year, she graced the Paryushan Parva celebration in Toronto, Canada. She will be with us from Tuesday, August 14 to Thursday, August 23, and will stay at the Jain Center.

Paryushan Parva is one of the most important and widely celebrated annual Jain festival for purification of our soul. It is the celebration of spiritual awareness. It not only gives us an opportunity to practice basic tenets of Jainism, but also motivates us to do soul searching, self-analysis, self-realization and introspection of the life we have led. It also promotes forgiveness for wrong doings performed intentionally or non-intentionally.

Swapna Ceremony

Swapna ceremony will be held on Saturday August 18th starting at 2:00 p.m. followed by Swami Vatsalya Bhojan. During the Swapna ceremony, members will have the honor of carrying to the beats of drums and music, the 14 Swapnas one by one to the stage as traditionally done in India. Gheeboli will be done for all the Swapnas, for swinging the Parnu, and for performing Arti and Mangal Divo. More than one family can join together in the Gheeboli. Since the dinner must be completed before dusk, the program on Saturday must start on time as shown. Members are requested to come on time.

Swapna Ceremony on Saturday, August 18 Directions to Benjamin Banneker School

From I-495: Take exit 30A for Route US 29 north. After 6 miles, turn left on the traffic light for Briggs Chaney Road. Make the first right on Old Columbia Road. Within 1 mile, turn left on Perrywood Drive. The school will be on your left.

From I-95: Take Exit 33 for Route 198 West to Burtonsville. After passing Route US 29, turn left on Old Columbia Road. After about 1 mile, turn right on Perrywood Drive. The school will be on your left.

From Jain Center: Turn right on Briggs Chaney Road. Turn left at the third traffic light for Old Columbia Road (just before US-29). Within 1 mile, turn left on Perrywood Drive. The school will be on your left.

Panch Teerth Yatra

The Panch Teerth Yatra will be during the weekend of September 8 & 9. We will visit temples at Cherryhill, North New Jersey, Siddhachalam, Allentown and Harrisburg. Note that the Cherryhill temple is now a Shikharbandi temple (Pratishtha was performed in June, 2001), and that we did not visit temples at Allentown and Harrisburg last year.
