Mahavir Jayanti was celebrated on Saturday, April 20th afternoon with a stage program followed by Swami Vatsalya Bhojan. program was held in the Paint Branch High School near our temple. The program started with singing of Jain prayers by Dr. Manoj Dharamsi followed by an excellent welcome speech by H.E. Ambassador Lalit Mansinghii. A special message for Mahavir Jayanti received from President George W. Bush was read by Dr. Sushil Jain. Vice President of JAINA. Our past youth coordinator Tejas Doshi gave an excellent presentation on "Mahavir and his teachings" which was very well received. It was followed by prayer dances performed by our young artists Payal Vora, Monali Shah, Meera Mehta and Pooja Mehta.
