JAINA Convention Update

For quite some time, we have been very concerned at deteriorating economic conditions in the U.S. and rest of the world and have been thinking about how best to minimize the impact of worsening situation on convention attendees and on JAINA. Our biennial conventions have a long and proud history of bringing Jains together and promoting the cause of Jainism. But the present conditions demand that we refocus the convention in a way that will still provide all the benefits of a traditional convention while reducing the cost of attending the convention. Accordingly, we have decided on the following changes:

The convention venue will be moved from Anaheim Convention Center to the Jain Center of Southern California's newly renovated Jain Bhavan in Los Angles. Their 62,000 sq. feet

cultural complex & 13,000 sq ft Temple successfully hosted 2500+ attendees during their Pratishtha Mahotsav in September 2008. We are quite confident that this site will be able to easily accommodate all our requirements. Please visit http://www.jaincenter.net/newsite/ for details.

Convention registration fee has been reduced significantly: Early bird Registration fee for adults has been reduced from \$150 to \$100 per person. Early bird registration deadline has been extended from March 15th to April 15th 2009.
