Board of Trustees Update

The Trustees are very happy to report that last month; we were successful in purchasing the 1.5 acres land on Ammendale Road adjacent to the 3.8 acres land we acquired in Beltsville, Maryland last year. The total cost of the 5.3 acres land is below \$525,000. The land is practically flat and has long frontage on the Ammendale Road. It will give us enough flexibility in building the Shikharbandhi Temple, Swadhya Hall, Class rooms, a Multipurpose Hall with Kitchen facility and a parking lot for over 125 cars. It is only quarter of a mile from I-95, and 2 miles from I-495. The BAPS Temple is only few feet away.

The next phase in achieving our goal of a Shikharbandhi Temple is to start raising funds. Keeping that goal in mind, we have planned a fund raising gala luncheon on Saturday April 30, 2011 from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm in Potomac, Maryland. Narendrabhai Nandu has kindly agreed to grace the program. The program will include a short drama written and directed by Narendrabhai, and performed by our members. Invitations for this program were mailed out to all members. All members are urged to come to this gala event.

On behalf of the Board of Trustees, I am making a strong appeal to all our members to donate generously for this auspicious cause and to help in any way they can to successfully complete this Temple building project.


