#### **JAINA Update**

#### **Legislative conference March 27**

Theme "Live and Help Live" Brings Jain Americans to Congress

JAINA, an umbrella organization for over 100 Jain organizations and 150,000 Jains across North America, came to Capitol Hill for its annual conference on March 27.

The theme of the one-day conference was "Live and Help live," with JAINA members hearing from numerous panelists regarding U.S. policy in the Middle East and South Asia, legislative advocacy and animal welfare. Speakers included a host of bipartisan members of Congress, including Ed Royce (R-CA) and Joe Crowley (D-NY) co-chairs of the Congressional Caucus on India and Indian Americans. Congressmen

Frank Pallone (D-NJ, Joe Wilson (R-SC), Dennis Kucinich (D-OH) and Jim McDermott, MD (D-WA) along with Congresswoman Ileana Ros-Lehtinen (R-FL), chairwoman of the House Foreign Affairs Committee, also joined the event.

The day began with discussions from JAINA attendees with senior officials from the Washington, D.C. office of the American Jewish Committee. The attendees then went to Capitol Hill for the afternoon portion of the program. The Chaplain of the U.S. House of Representatives, Father Patrick J. Conroy, began the conference with a prayer, while Dr. Manoj Dharamsi, Public Affairs Council Chairman for JAINA, led the attendees in a Jain prayer. Dr. Sushil Jain, president of JAINA and former active-duty U.S. Naval officer, provided welcoming remarks.

A highlight of the conference was the keynote address and remarks by Atul Keshap, Director of the State Department's South Asia Desk covering India, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Maldives and Bangladesh. Elizabeth Kucinich, director of public affairs for the Physicians Committee for Responsible Medicine (PCRM), discussed legislative items important to organization and possible partnership with Jain members on issues pertaining to animal welfare. She focused on the health benefits to a plant-based diet, noting that she and her husband congressman Kucinich were both vegans. PCRM seeks the elimination of animal use for medical training. To improve the health of Americans, especially children, she emphasized the necessity for increasing plant-based foods for children and reducing the consumption of meat. She noted people were more aware of mistreatment of animals for food and research purposes, but emphasized the need for further action.

At the end of the conference, attendees received an escorted tour of the U.S. Capitol Building and Capitol Visitor Center and then finished the evening at a reception on Capitol Hill attended by congressmen and congressional staff.
