- We have received proposals from six (6) A/E firms and two (2) civil engineering firms.
- These proposals are currently under evaluation by Construction Committee and the technical evaluation is expected to be completed by 29 March 2014.
- The committee will open the price proposals on 30 March 2014 and will shortlist three (3) design firms.
- Recommendation report will be submitted to the Board of Trustees & Temple Committee for approval by 3 April 2014.
- Approval & Finalizing of three (3) short listed firms is expected to be completed by 6 April 2014.
- The shortlisted firms will be invited for making presentations on 12 April 2014.
- The design firm for the temple project will be finalized following the presentations on 12 April 2014.
- Letter of Intent (LOI) will be issued to the successful design firm by 19 April 2014.
- The design firm principals will be invited at the Mahavir Jayanti program.
- Three (3) demolition contractors visited the site on 22 March 2014.
- Two (2) proposals received from Sompura Architects.
