



## Jain Center Re-opening Process

- Allow the safe practice of Darshan only at this time at our Jain Center
- Limit unnecessary contact between people
- Minimize contact with surfaces in Jain Center
- Maintain a clean facility

**We are pleased to announce that the Jain Center will be open for Darshan on Saturdays and Sundays starting, Saturday, June 20, 2020 with the following processes and limitations in place.**

### Visiting the Jain Center

Entry to the Jain Center will be by appointment via signing up through Signup Genius at:

If you are sick with fever, cough or other respiratory symptoms, do not visit the Jain Center. If you have a high risk condition or are older than 65 years old, it is also not recommended to visit the Jain Center.

This Signup will be posted at the Jain Center live. Please ensure others exit the temple before entering. There is a television with live webcast of the temple to ensure no others are in the temple when you are entering.

The Jain Center will only be open **ONLY FOR DARSHAN** on **Saturday and Sunday** from **8am-630pm** in this phase.

- Kesar Pooja/Pooja cannot be done to minimize touching unnecessary surfaces.
- Please bring your own books to read from or use your own devices.

To access the Jain Center, the code will be communicated to you in your confirmation email.

### **While at the Jain Center**

- Please follow the arrow directions for flow through the Jain Center and Temple.
- Wear a mask or facial covering (covering nose and mouth) at all times while on the Jain Center premises (JSMW will not provide masks).
- Please use the provided hand sanitizer to keep your hands clean.
- Restrooms are closed except for emergency use.

### **Limitations at the Jain Center (as of 6/20/2020)**

- Only Darshan, Chaitya Vandan, Bhakti is permitted at this time.
- No more than 10 people should be in the Jain Center at a time and all should be living as one family under one roof.

### **Cleaning process at Jain Center**

- The Jain Center will be cleaned every day that visitors enter.
