

NEW TEMPLE & JAIN CENTER PROJECT UPDATE (AS OF 8/1/2022)

Construction of our New Jain Center in next nine to eighteen months will be very critical. In addition to DD&B building construction work, Marble installation has also started. Marble carving, FRP and FRP Support steel fabrication work and shipping of marble/FRP/FRP Support Steel from India is going on in full swing with progressive updates each week. Each day passing, we are coming closer to Pratishtha Mahotsay.

Thank you to the entire Temple Committee and various sub-committees for their hard work and dedication. Let us all continue to work together to make our dreams turn into a reality. Detailed report is as follow:

Construction and Sitework:

- Most of the Sitework is completed.
- o General Contractor (DD&B) is working on the temple and building construction, as per current schedule, their portion of the construction work is estimated to be completed around October/November 2022 timeframe.
- Marble/FRP Installation Sub-Contractor is working on the Marble Installation.
- Total 6 containers of marble have arrived so far from India. Next shipment of 2 containers is targeted in end of August 2022.
- o FRP material is under construction in India, shipping is expected around

October/November 2022 timeframe.

- construction Team is working on selection of designer wooden doors (For Main Doors, Ghabhara Doors etc.)
- A/V work coordination with DD&B in Progress.
- Marble Pratimaji work is ongoing in India.

Policy Sub-Committee:

The Policy Sub-Committee have prepared Initial Draft Policy Documents for (a) Facility Usage and Renting Policy, (b) Performing Pooja and other Rituals, (c) Food Policy, (d) Visiting Scholars and (e) Education Policy. Have requested and received feedback on the Draft Education Policy from the Education Directors & some teachers and are in the process of revising our draft Education Policy based on the feedback received.

Process Sub-Committee:

The Process Sub-Committee is nearing completion on two processes (Communication and Passing of a Member), for formal submission to the Temple Committee, and pending the Committee's approval, for formal submission to the BoT and the EC. The team is at 4 members and is currently looking for members interested in creating documentation. The team is working on several other processes and has a few additional processes for the future. AV Sub Committee:

The A/V technology subcommittee had several meetings with Clear Connection and DD&B to finalize the low voltage requirements / changes and schedules. The process of installing all the low voltage cables will be starting in August by our vendor Clear Connection alongside DD&B construction process.

If you are ever in the area, please swing by the construction site and visualize our grand New Temple and Jain Center standing there in just a few years.

- Aarya Jain (Jatin Jain & Parul Nagda): "Following Ahimsa just because we were told to by our
 pathshala teachers or parents has a different impact than when you realize the "why" behind
 it and do it yourself, and that is a key thing pathshala has taught me."
- Daksh Jain (Sheetal & Poonam Jain): "Respecting every form of life, be it plants, animals or human beings, and not hurting them in anyway is Jainism."
- Haeli Shah (Manan & Monali Shah): "Pathshala has taught me that there is always a more significant reason behind actions and thoughts. Without knowing those thoughts, you could be participating in something dangerous and destructive."
- Jahnavi Shah (Jignesh & Jaimini Shah): "Without knowing, I've applied Jainism to my everyday life as if it was second nature. Even the little things are part of following Jainism."
- Khushi Doshi (Nilesh & Megha Doshi): "Our religion even states that we shouldn't have blind fate and our brain should be free from doubt."
- Mallina Shah (Parash & Rina Shah): "One may never remain unbiased as they are constantly influenced by external factors. But, when one is confronted with the choice, one must understand the Leshyas and how their actions reflect their state of being."

27 Parshwanath Bhaav Yatra With Shri Narendra Bhai Nandu

Venue: High Point High School, starting at 1 pm

On August 13th, 2022, JSMW will celebrate the 27 Parshwanath Bhaav Yatra program along with Shri Narendra bhai Nandu and Megh Nandu. This program is an obeisance to our Mulnaayak Shri Parshwanath Bhagwan and will take us through a bhaav yatra. During this program, he will also perform following Gheebolis:

- Bharai for Shantinath Bhagwan Pratimaji in Shwetambar Derasar Ghabhara.
- Second Bharai Labh for Adinath, Munisuvrat Swami and Neminath Bhagwan Pratimajis in the Shwetambar Derasar Ghabhara (Note: Current Bharai Labharthi families have allowed one more Bharai Labharthi for each Pratimaji).
- Bharai of Parshwanath Bhagwan Pratimaji in the Digambar Derasar Ghabhara
- Second Bharai Labh for Mahavir Swami Pratimaji in the Digambar Derasar Ghabhara. (Note: Current Bharai Labharthi family has allowed one more Labharthi for Bharai Labh).
- Bharai of Shantinath Bhagwan Pratimaji in Digambar Derasar Rang Mandap
- Anjan Shalaka Labh of Silver Parshwanath Murti and Siddhachakra Gatto
- Performing Anjan Shalaka Vidhis; viz., (a) Preparing Anjan (Ghutvanu), and offering (b) Anjan, (c) Silk Clothes, and (d) Gold Thali with Vatki and Sali to Maharaj Saheb for performing Anjan Shalaka Vidhi. (Note: Anjan preparation (Ghutwanu) can be performed only by a young girl (age below 9-10 years) who has not started menstrual periods.
- Sponsoring Uvasaggaharam and Mangalik Patts in Sthanak.

Members are encouraged to attend this special program and take part in the Gheebolis for the very auspicious and important Anjan Shalaka Labhs and participate in the Anjan Shalaka program which will be held in Koba near Ahmedabad from Nov 25 to 30, 2022. Even if you do not plan to attend the Anjan Shalaka program in India, you can take Bharai or Patt Labh. Your presence during the Anjan Shalaka ceremony is not a requirement for these Labhs. Bharai Labh is very auspicious and is considered as a must for all Jains.

All members are encouraged to plan to attend this special program and to take advantage of getting at least one of the above listed very auspicious once-in-a-lifetime Labhs.


